# **Description**

#### In Favor:-

- Political knowledge matters a lot rather attaining academic one. The intelligence of someone doesn't depend on degrees but on his political achievements.

### Situation in India:-

- There is no education required to become an MP or MLA in our country. The Constitution while mentioning the various eligibility conditions does not mention anything about educational qualification.
- â€<u>Rajasthan</u>†is the first State to fix a minimum educational qualification for contesting elections to Panchayati Raj Institutions.

# Situation in other countries:-

- Most of the Chinese politicians are have engineering degrees similarly majority of politicians in Asian countries like South Korea, Malaysia, even Taiwan have well qualified politicians.
- The presidents of U.S.A. and Russia Obama and Putin were among the world's most educated political leaders.
